Københavns Internationale Teater / Metropolis søger dansere, parkourudøvere, cirkusartister og atleter til 'bodies in urban spaces' af den østrigske koreograf Willi Dorner.

Koreograf Willi Dorner tager i sine værker favntag med hverdagen og tilbyder tilskuerne et friskt perspektiv på deres by. Siden 2007 har han præsenteret 'bodies in urban spaces' i 100 byer over hele verden, herunder København i 2011.

Nu fejrer vi 10 år for 'bodies in urban spaces' med en ekstra large version. I alt 45 europæiske og lokale dansere, parkourudøvere, artister og atleter på en 8 km strækning tværs gennem København – sammen med publikum.

Under gesimsen hænger en sammenrullet mand. En kvinde sidder i spænd i et hul i muren. En slange af kulørte mennesker smyger sig op ad en trappe. Lige så hurtigt som billederne opstår, lige så hurtigt forsvinder de igen, og udforskningen af byen fortsætter et nyt sted.

'Bodies in urban spaces' iscenesætter en bevægelig sti gennem byen. Performerne danner en kæde af fysiske, fastfrosne øjeblikke, som kiler sig ind i byens mellemrum og går i clinch med dens struktur, dens arkitektur og dens rytmer.

OPEN CALL for BODIES IN URBAN SPACES

Københavns Internationale Teater / Metropolis is looking for dancers, circus artists and athletes for 'bodies in urban spaces' by Austrian choreographer Willi Dorner.

Choreographer Willi Dorner embraces everyday life and offers audiences a fresh perspective on their city. Since 2007, 'bodies in urban spaces' has been presented in 100 cities all over the world, a.o. in Copenhagen in 2011.

Now we celebrate 10 years for 'bodies in urban spaces' with an extra-large version. 45 European and local dancers, artists and athletes crisscross Copenhagen on an 8 km route - together with the audience.

About 'bodies in urban spaces'

'bodies in urban spaces' is a moving trail through the city, choreographed for a group of dancers. The performers lead the audience through selected parts of public and semi-public spaces. A chain of physical interventions set up very quickly and only existing temporarily allows the viewer to perceive the same space or place in a new and different way - on the run.

'bodies in urban spaces' is a temporary intervention in diversified urban architectonic environments. The intention is to point out the urban functional structure and to uncover the restricted movement possibilities and behaviour as well as rules and limitations. 'Bodies in urban spaces' invites the residents to walk their own city to establish a stronger relationship to their city. The interventions are temporary without leaving other traces behind but imprints in the eye-witnesses memory.
